Genuine Reason	Evidence required for an Individual

Professional Hunter	The applicant is to provide current written evidence that is dated within the last 12 months, indicating that the applicant is substantially dependant on hunting as a source of income and provide the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A current letter from the applicant's tax agent demonstrating that income was derived from professional hunting; and2. Copies of contracts or formal agreements to hunt professionally; and3. A letter that describes the quarry the applicant intends to hunt, stating why the specific category of licence is required, and why a lesser category of firearm could not meet these needs.
