Heirloom	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The applicant is to provide an explanation of why they cannot meet the requirements to obtain a licence under any other provision of Part 2 of the <i>Firearms Act 1996</i>; and2. A copy of either a Will or Statutory Declaration stating that the applicant is to inherit a single firearm or a matching pair through a deceased estate.

Note: Proof of Inheritance – the applicant can only inherit from a person who is deceased and that deceased person must be a family member of which you are a descendant of i.e. parent, grandparent, uncle, aunt, brother or sister etc.
